It seems counter-intuitive to be talking about the need for hot water as the UK has sweltered through its latest heatwave, but it is of course a salutatory reminder of the very real impact of carbon emission on the atmosphere and the resultant extremes of climate produced.

If the soaring temperatures have driven home the reality of climate change, the Climate Change Committee (CCC) latest progress report has painted a bleak picture of the government's delivery on net zero so far. For all the political rhetoric, the CCC observed that once again emissions are on the rise, up 4% in 2021 compared with 2020, and it has delivered a list of hundreds of <u>recommendations</u> to put policy back on track.

In spite of the temperature, domestic hot water (DHW) systems still remain a business-critical function for a large proportion of the commercial sector, requiring anywhere from 10 to 70% of a building's energy demands. The hospitality sector has particular demands for hot water, with restaurants and catering having high demands with peak service and clean down. Hotels can combine those demands from inhouse food service with the additional 24/7 needs for basin, baths and showers throughout the accommodations. These are also industries that are already recognising and embracing the opportunities of marketing with their green credentials.
